Energy Star Tax Credit

As of January 1, 2009 the State of Indiana is providing a state income tax credit when certain Energy Star rated equipment is purchased by a homeowner or small business owner. The credit, worth as much as \$100 can be used when purchasing a furnace, a water heater, central air conditioning, room air conditioner or a programmable thermostat. Homeowners and small business owners can claim the credit on their state income tax return.
